RECEIVING FROM THE FATHER OF LIGHTS

FAITH TO ACCESS

Romans 5:1-2

- 1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:
- 2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

FAITH TO RECEIVE

Matthew 6:9-10, 21-24

- 9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.
- 10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.
- 21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.
- 22 The light of the body is the eye: <u>if therefore thine eye be single</u> (Interwoven into Christ), thy whole body shall be full of light.
- 23 But if thine eye be evil (full labours, toil, hardships, annoyances,) thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!
- 24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

James 1:5-8, 17

- 5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; (with reprimanding or finding fault) and it shall be given him.
- 6 But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.
- 7 For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord.
- 8 A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.
 - James 1:8 (NLT) Their loyalty is divided between God and the world...
 - **❖ Wavering:** (diakrinō) to separate thoroughly, to withdraw from, doubt, to stagger.
 - ❖ Romans 4:20-21

He staggered not (diakrino) at the promise of God through unbelief...

Hebrews 11:11

Through faith also Sara herself received strength (dunamis) to conceive seed...

Mark 11:22, 24

- 22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.
- 24 Therefore I say unto you, What things so ever ye desire (ask), when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

❖ Faith: "pistis"

Believe: "pisteo - from pistis"
