# THE INHERITANCE OF THE NAME OF JESUS

#### Hebrews 1:1-3

- 1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,
- 2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;
- 3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high.
  - Matthew 26:64

Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the Right Hand of Power ... (Right Hand of Dunamis Power)

### John 16:15

All things that the Father hath are mine: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall shew it unto you.

## Ephesians 1:3

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:

For it pleased the Father that in him should all fullness dwell;

# Psalms 2:6-8

- 6 Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.
- 7 I will declare the decree: the Lord hath said unto me, Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee.
- 8 Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen (nations) for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession. (Acts 13:33)

## Daniel 7:13-14

- 13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.
- 14 And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

# Revelation 5:12 7 - Fold Inheritance

Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.

#### Matthew 28:18

Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

II Corinthians 8:9

For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.

Isaiah 65:9

I will bring forth a seed out of Jacob, and out of Judah an inheritor of my mountains: (Mt Hebron) and mine elect shall inherit it, and my servants shall dwell there.

Isaiah 9:6-7

- 6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.
- 7 Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even forever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.

Psalms 68:18

Thou hast ascended on high, thou hast led captivity captive: thou hast received gifts for men...

- Ephesians 4:8-11
  - 8 Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.
  - 11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;

Psalms 22:28

For the kingdom is the Lord's: and he is the governor among the nations.

Isaiah 53:4-5

- 4 <u>Surely he hath borne our griefs</u> (sickness), <u>and carried our sorrows:</u> (pains) yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
- 5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: <u>the</u> chastisement of our peace (lack of peace) was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Isaiah 53:7

He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: <u>he is brought as a lamb</u> to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

❖ 1 Corinthians 1:30

But of him are <u>ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom,</u> and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption.
