

THE CYRUS - TRUMP GENERATION

Isaiah 45:1-6

1 **Thus saith the LORD to his anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have holden, to subdue nations before him; and I will loose the loins of kings, to open before him the two leaved gates; and the gates shall not be shut;**

2 I will go before thee, and make the crooked places straight: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron:

3 And **I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places**, that thou mayest know that I, the LORD, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel.

Ezra 1:2

Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, The LORD God of heaven hath given me all the kingdoms of the earth; **and he hath charged me to build him an house at Jerusalem**, which is in Judah.

Ezra 3:2, 7

2 **Then stood up Joshua** the son of Jozadak, and his brethren the priests, **and Zerubbabel ...**

7 **They (Zerubbabel and Joshua) gave money** also unto the masons, and to the carpenters; and meat, and drink, and oil, unto them of Zidon, and to them of Tyre, to bring cedar trees from Lebanon to the sea of Joppa, **according to the grant that they had of Cyrus king of Persia.**

Ezekiel 26:2-5, 7

2 **Son of man, because that Tyrus hath said against Jerusalem, Aha, she is broken that was the gates of the people: she is turned unto me: I shall be replenished, now she is laid waste:**

3 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against thee, O Tyrus, and will cause many nations to come up against thee, as the sea causeth his waves to come up.

4 And they shall destroy the walls of Tyrus, and break down her towers: I will also scrape her dust from her, and make her like the top of a rock.

5 **It shall be a place for the spreading of nets in the midst of the sea:** for I have spoken it, saith the Lord GOD: and it shall become a spoil to the nations.

7 For thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, **I will bring upon Tyrus Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon**, a king of kings, from the north, with horses, and with chariots, and with horsemen, and companies, and much people.

Ezekiel 28:12-15

12 Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the **king of Tyrus**, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty.

13 **Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God;** every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created.

14 **Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth;** and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire.

15 Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.

Isaiah 23:3

1 **The burden of Tyre ...**

3 By great waters the seed of Sihor, the harvest of the river, is her revenue; **she is a mart of nations.**

Isaiah 23:15-18

15 And it shall come to pass in that day, **that Tyre shall be forgotten seventy years**, according to the days of one king: after the end of seventy years shall Tyre sing as an harlot.

16 Take an harp, go about the city, thou harlot that hast been forgotten; make sweet melody, sing many songs, that thou mayest be remembered.

17 **And it shall come to pass after the end of seventy years**, that the LORD will visit Tyre, and she shall turn to her hire, **and shall commit (financial) fornication with all the kingdoms of the world upon the face of the earth.**

18 **And her merchandise and her hire shall be holiness to the LORD: it shall not be treasured nor laid up; for her merchandise shall be for them that dwell before the LORD, to eat sufficiently, and for durable clothing.**

Haggai 2:4-9

4 **Yet now be strong, O Zerubbabel, saith the LORD; and be strong, O Joshua**, son of Josedech, the high priest; and be strong, all ye people of the land, saith the LORD, and work: for I am with you, saith the LORD of hosts:

5 According to the word that I covenanted with you when ye came out of Egypt, so my spirit remaineth among you: fear ye not.

6 For thus saith the LORD of hosts; Yet once, it is a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry land;

7 **And I will shake all nations, and the desire (treasures) of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, saith the LORD of hosts.**

8 **The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of hosts.**

9 **The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former (Solomon's House)**, saith the LORD of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, saith the LORD of hosts.

Zechariah 4:6-7, 10

6 Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, **This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.**

7 Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and **he shall bring forth the headstone (Capstone, NLT - Final Stone)** thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it.

10 For who hath despised the day of small things? for they shall rejoice, **and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven; they are the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth.**

Revelation 4:1, 5

1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, **Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.**

5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: **and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.**

Revelation 5:6-10

6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, **which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.**

10 **And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.**

US FORMALLY ACKNOWLEDGES JERUSALEM AS THE CAPITAL OF ISRAEL

On May 14, 1948, as the Jews of Palestine declared the establishment of a Jewish state, called Israel, U.S. President Harry Truman granted immediate recognition on behalf of the United States, becoming the first head of state to do so.

On May 14, 2018, 70 years later, President Donald Trump will move U.S. Embassy operations to Jerusalem from Tel Aviv, where it has been since 1966.

U.S. Ambassador to Israel David Friedman, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and U.S. Deputy Secretary of State John J. Sullivan will speak. U.S. Treasury Secretary Steven T. Mnuchin and Jared Kushner and Ivanka Trump will also be attending the ceremony.
