THE DOOR OF TIME HABITATION

Omnipresence, Omniscience, Omnipotence

Revelation 1:10, 12-13, 20

10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,

- 12 And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;
- 13 And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.
- 20 <u>The mystery of the seven stars</u> which thou sawest in my right hand, <u>and the seven golden</u> candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels (messengers) of the seven churches: <u>and the seven</u> candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.
 - ❖ John was given a word of prophecy, instruction, encouragement, admonition and rebukes.

Revelation 4:1-2, 5

- 1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; (NIV voice I had first heard speaking with as a trumpet) which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.
- 2 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne.
- 5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: <u>and there were seven</u> <u>lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.</u>
 - First thing John sees is the events of Revelation Chapter 5 and 6.
 - Revelation 5:1, 4-5, 11
 - 1 And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.
 - 4 And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.
 - 5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.
 - 11 And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne ...
 - ❖ Revelation 6:1-7
 - 1 And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.
 - 2 And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.
 - Come and See v.3 Red Horse, v.5 Black Horse, v.7 Pale Horse
 - Revelation 7:9-15 John interacts with the elder concerning the great harvest of souls
 - Revelation 17:1-7 John carried away in the spirit and sees the Great Harlot Mystery Babylon
 - Revelation 21:9-11 John carried away in the spirit and sees the Bride of Christ

Revelation 3:7-8

- 7 And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;
- 8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.
- ❖ Isaiah 22:15, 20-22
 - 15 Thus saith the Lord GOD of hosts, **Go, get thee unto this treasurer, even unto Shebna, which is over the house,** and say,
 - 20 And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will call my servant Eliakim the son of Hilkiah:
 - 21 And I will clothe him with thy robe, and strengthen him with thy girdle, and I will commit thy government into his hand: and he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to the house of Judah.
 - 22 And the key of the house of David will I lay upon his shoulder; so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open.

Revelation 3:20

Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup (dine) with him, and he with me. (will dine with Me where I am)

Proverbs 8:34-35

- 34 Blessed is the man that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors.
- 35 For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD.

Proverbs 9:1-5

- 1 Wisdom hath builded her house, she hath hewn out her seven pillars:
- 2 She hath killed her beasts; she hath mingled her wine; she hath also furnished her table.
- 3 She hath sent forth her maidens: she crieth upon the highest places of the city,
- 4 Whoso is simple, let him turn in hither: as for him that wanteth understanding, she saith to him,
- 5 Come, eat of my bread, and drink of the wine which I have mingled.
- Proverbs 8:1-4, 6, 12, 14-21
 - 1 Doth not wisdom cry? and understanding put forth her voice?
 - 2 She standeth in the top of high places, by the way in the places of the paths.
 - 3 She crieth at the gates, at the entry of the city, at the coming in at the doors.
 - 4 Unto you, O men, I call; and my voice is to the sons of man.
 - 6 Hear; for I will speak of excellent things (princely things, kingly things); and the opening of my lips shall be right things.
 - 12 I wisdom dwell with prudence, and find out knowledge of witty inventions. (mezimmâh evil machinations, schemes, plans. sometimes good)
 - 14 Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom: I am understanding; I have strength.
 - 15 By me kings reign, and princes decree justice.
 - 16 By me princes rule, and nobles, even all the judges of the earth.
 - 17 I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me.
 - 18 Riches and honour are with me; yea, durable riches and righteousness.
 - 19 My fruit is better than gold, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver.
 - 20 I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment:
 - 21 That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures.
