# THE MYSTERY OF DUNAMIS CREATIVE POWER

### HE KEPT SAYING TO ME, "FINISH THE PRAYER"

Ephesians 3:14-20

14 For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,

15 Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,

16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened (empowered) with might (dunamis) by his Spirit in the inner man;

17 That Christ (The Anointed) may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,

18 May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;

19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

20 Now unto him that is able to do, exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think (imagine), according to the power (dunamis) that worketh in us,

- v. 16 Father I ask that You grant me according to riches of the glory that are in Christ Jesus; to be strengthened, empowered, overshadowed and infused with all creative dunamis power, dunamis virtue, dunamis life and dunamis provision.
- **Dunamis:** Strong's Force, miraculous power, ability, might, power and strength, abundance.
  - Thayer Power for performing miracles. The power and influence which belong to riches and wealth
  - H.S. Definition The creative substance of divine essence and power that works in conjunction with the Word, of which the Holy Spirit employs to tangibly manifest the Spiritual Kingdom of God in the natural earth realm.

#### Romans 1:20

For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power (dunamis) and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

Luke 5:17

It came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power (dunamis) of the Lord was present to heal them.

Luke 8:43-46

43 A woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed of any,

44 Came behind him, and touched the border of his garment: and immediately her issue of blood stanched.

45 And Jesus said, Who touched me? When all denied, Peter and they that were with him said,
Master, the multitude throng thee and press thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me?
46 Jesus said, Somebody hath touched me: for I perceive that virtue (dunamis) is gone out of me.

Luke 6:12-13, 17-19

12 And it came to pass in those days, that he went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God.

13 And when it was day, he called unto him his disciples: and of them he chose twelve, whom also he named apostles;

17 And he came down with them, and stood in the plain, and the company of his disciples, and a great multitude of people out of all Judaea and Jerusalem, and from the sea coast of Tyre and Sidon, which came to hear him, and to be healed of their diseases;

18 And they that were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed.

19 <u>And the whole multitude sought to touch him: <mark>for there went virtue</mark> (dunamis) <mark>out of him, and</mark> <u>healed them all.</u></u>

Acts 3:1-8

Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour.
And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple;

3 Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked an alms.

4 And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us.

5 And he gave heed unto them, expecting to receive something of them.

6 <u>Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; <mark>but such as I have</mark> give I thee</mark>: <mark>In the name of Jesus</mark> Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.</u>

7 And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.

8 And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.

## John 2:1-11

1 And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there:

2 And both Jesus was called, and his disciples, to the marriage.

3 And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto him, <u>They have no wine.</u>

4 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, what have I to do with thee? mine hour is not yet come.

5 His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.

6 And there were set there <u>six waterpots of stone</u>, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece.

7 Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.

8 <u>And he saith unto them, <mark>Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare</mark> <mark>it.</mark></u>

9 When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom, 10 And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now.

11 **<u>This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee</u>, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.**
