THE MYSTERY OF THE 3 MEASURES - KINGDOM MANIFESTATION

Matthew 13: 31-33

Another parable spake he unto them; The kingdom of heaven is like unto leaven, which a woman took, and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened.

Hebrews 11:1-3

Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed (created, fashioned, set in order) by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

Romans 1:20

For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power (dunamis) and Godhead...

Luke 12:31-32

- 31 But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you.
- 32 Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.
- 1 Corinthians 4:18-20

For the kingdom of God is not in word (only), but in power (dunamis).

1 Thessalonians 1:5

For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power (dunamis), and in the Holy Ghost and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.

THE 3 MEASURES IN THE MINISTRY OF CHRIST

Luke 4:14, 31-32, 36-37

- 14 And <u>Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit</u> into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.
- 31 And came down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and taught them on the sabbath days.
- 32 And they were astonished at his doctrine: for his word was with power (exousia authority).
- 36 And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word is this! for with authority (exousia) and power (dunamis), he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.
- 37 And the fame of him went out into every place of the country round about.
 - Jesus held a Revival at Peter's home that day.

JESUS SENDS OUT THE 12 & THE 70 WITH THE 3 MEASURES

Luke 9:1-2, 6

- 1 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power (dunamis), and authority (exousia) over all devils, and to cure diseases.
- 2 And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.
- 6 And they departed, and went through the towns, preaching the gospel, and healing every here.

Luke 10:1, 9, 17-19

- 1 <u>After these things the Lord appointed other seventy also</u>, and sent them two and two before his face into every city and place, whither he himself would come.
- 9 And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.
- 17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. (Their First Trial Run)
- 18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.
- 19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Mark 16:15-20

- 15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.
- 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; **they shall lay** hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God.
- 20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

THE 3 MEASURES IN THE BOOK OF ACTS

Acts 1:8

<u>Ye shall receive power</u> (dunamis), <u>after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you:</u> and ye shall be witnesses unto me ...

Acts 3:1-7

- 6 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.
- 7 And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.
- 16 And his name through faith in his name hath made this man strong, whom ye see and know: yea, the faith which is by him hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.

Acts 4:29-33 Peter's Response to the Threatenings of The High Priest

- 29 And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word,
- 30 By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.
- 31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.
- 33 And with great power (dunamis) gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.
