UNDERSTANDING THE TRANSFIGURATION OF CHRIST

Revelation 1:4-5, 8, 10-16

- 4 John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne;
- 5 And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead...
- 8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.
- 10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,
- 11 <u>Saying, I am Alpha and Omega</u>, <u>the first and the last:</u> and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.
- 12 And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;
- 13 And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.
- 14 His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire;
- 15 And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters.
- 16 And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp two-edged sword: and-bis-countenance-was-as-the-sun-shineth-in-his-strength.

MT. OF TRANSFIGURATION - THE OVERSHADOWING

Matthew 17:1-9

- 1 <u>After six days</u> Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, <u>and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,</u>
- 2 And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.
- 3 And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias talking with him.
- 4 Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: if thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.
- 5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.
- 6 And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were sore afraid.
- 7 And Jesus came and touched them, and said, Arise, and be not afraid.
- 8 And when they had lifted up their eyes, they saw no man, save Jesus only.
- 9 And as they came down from the mountain, <u>Jesus charged them, saying</u>, <u>Tell the vision to no man,</u> <u>until the Son of man be risen again from the dead.</u>

Mark 9:2-10

- 2 <u>After six days</u> Jesus taketh with him Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and he was transfigured before them.
- 3 And his raiment became shining, exceeding white as snow; so as no fuller on earth can white them.
- 4 And there appeared unto them Elias with Moses: and they were talking with Jesus.
- 5 And Peter answered and said to Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.
- 6 For he wist not what to say; for they were sore afraid.
- 7 And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him.
- 8 And suddenly, when they had looked round about, they saw no man any more, save Jesus only with themselves.
- 9 And as they came down from the mountain, <u>he charged them that they should tell no man what</u> things they had seen, till the Son of man were risen from the dead.
- 10 And they kept that saying with themselves, <u>questioning one with another what the rising from</u> the dead should mean.

Luke 9:28-35

- 28 And it came to pass about an eight days after these sayings, he took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to pray.
- 29 And as he prayed, the fashion of his countenance was altered, and his raiment was white and glistering.
- 30 And, behold, there talked with him two men, which were Moses and Elias:
- 31 Who appeared in glory, and spake of his decease which he should accomplish at Jerusalem.
- 32 But Peter and they that were with him were heavy with sleep: and when they were awake, they saw his glory, and the two men that stood with him.
- 33 And it came to pass, as they departed from him, Peter said unto Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias: not knowing what he said.
- 34 While he thus spake, there came a cloud, and overshadowed them: and they feared as they entered into the cloud.
- 35 And there came a voice out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him.
 - ❖ V.32 Deep Sleep (hypnos) where we get the english word hypnosis.
 - ❖ Genesis 2:21 Adam

<u>The LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam</u>, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof;

- ❖ Genesis 15:12-17 Abraham
 - 12 When the sun was going down, <u>a deep sleep fell upon Abram; and, lo, an horror of great</u> darkness fell upon him.
 - 17 It came to pass, that, when the sun went down, and it was dark, <u>behold a smoking furnace</u>, <u>and a burning lamp that passed between those pieces</u>.
- ❖ Daniel 10:5-10 Daniel
 - 6 His body also was like the beryl, <u>and his face as the appearance of lightning</u>, and his eyes as lamps of fire, and his arms and his feet like in colour to polished brass, and the voice of his words like the voice of a multitude.
 - 9 Yet heard I the voice of his words: and when I heard the voice of his words, then was I in a deep sleep on my face, and my face toward the ground.
